

The Inland Empire Collie Club provides four categories of membership for new members:

- Regular Membership – Individuals have full privileges of club membership including voting and holding office. All regular members are counted when determining a quorum at meetings. Applicants must attend two club events (meetings, social events, competitive events sponsored by IECC) within a four month period. Dues - \$12.50/year
- Household Membership – Two people in the same household each have full privileges of club membership including voting and holding office. Each member of the household has a separate vote, and each is counted in calculating a quorum. Both applicants for a household membership must attend 2 club events (meetings, social events, competitive events sponsored by IECC) within a four month period. Dues - \$15.00/year
- Associate Membership – Individuals have all club privileges except they may not vote or hold office. Associate members are not counted when determining a quorum at meetings. Applicants do not need to attend club events before applying, but must obtain sponsorship from two club members. Dues - \$10.00 per year
- Junior Membership – Individuals between 10 to 17 years of age have all club privileges except they may not vote or hold office. Junior members are not counted when determining a quorum at meetings. Applicants do not need to attend club events before applying, but must obtain sponsorship from two club members. Dues - \$10.00 per year
